

ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT POLICY

Environmental Policy Aims

1. Environmental Improvement

We intend wherever possible, to make continual progress in our environmental performance and to reduce our environmental impact whilst maintaining the Company's economic viability.

2. Environmental Legislation

We will ensure that all Company operations and activities carried out on behalf of the Company, comply with or exceed all statutory environmental requirements.

3. Protection of our Environment

We aim to improve our environmental performance and reduce environmental impacts by adopting the principles of best practice and best technology wherever possible. We shall do this with respect to:

3.1 Wise use of energy, water and other natural resources

We will conserve energy and other natural resources by adopting water and energy saving measures in Company buildings and reducing the amount of fuel used by vehicles used on Company business.

3.2 Wise use of Manufactured Materials

We will purchase goods and materials that can be manufactured and disposed of in an environmentally sustainable way. Aim to reduce the volume of paper used in the Company and ensure that we buy paper that maximises recycling and minimises environmental damage throughout its whole life cycle.

3.3 Minimisation and Safe Disposal of Waste

We will undertake to reduce the amount of waste produced by the Company and provide opportunities and facilities to maximise the quantity that is recycled, both of the Company's own waste and also waste collected from the sites. Roofing Maintenance Services Limited currently recycles glass, paper, wood, plastics and have separate waste containers for asbestos cement materials and general waste which is non-recyclable.

3.4 We will minimise and eliminate wherever possible, the release of any pollutant that may cause environmental damaged to air, water or land. As well as conserving energy we will also aim to undertake to reduce the quantity of emissions from Company buildings and aim to run a cleaner vehicle fleet as and when vehicles come up for renewal.

4 Risk Reduction

We will minimise the risk of environmental damage by employing safer technologies and operating procedures. We will prepare contingency procedures to deal with environmental accidents.

5 Staff Training

We will aim to provide environmental training for all employees as and when appropriate.

6 Subcontractors and Suppliers

We will work with our subcontractors and suppliers to help them improve their environmental performance and ensure that when working for the Company they adopt equivalent environmental standards.
